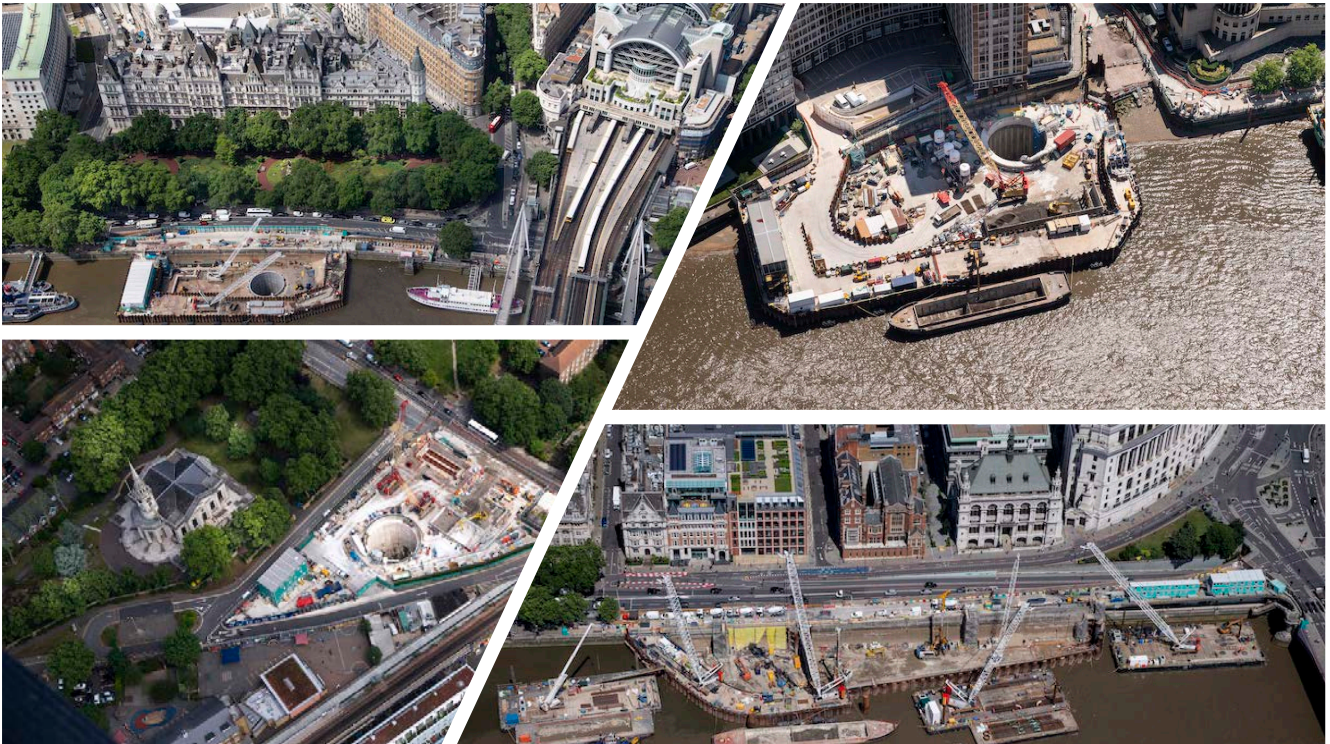

Tideway are upgrading London's sewerage system to cope with the demands of the city well into the 22nd century. After years of study, construction work is progressing for the new 25-kilometer interception, storage and transfer tunnel running up to 66 meters below the river, known as the Tideway Tunnel.

Built from three main construction drive sites in Fulham, Battersea and Southwark, the Thames Tideway Tunnel is expected to take seven years to build, at a cost of up to £5 billion. It will require the use of 24 construction sites, 11 of which are located along the river bank.
